


### DIVERSITY INFORMATION FOR MSU AND REGION

- Morehead State University about 11,000 students enrolled
- Approximately 1600 staff and faculty
- Underrepresented minorities comprise less than 7% of any group (student, staff, faculty)
- African American undergraduates = 2.8%
- Latino undergraduates = 1.6%


















## DIVERSITY TERMS, CONTINUED




## DIVERSITY TERMS, CONTINUED

 Marginalization – considering those without dominant culture characteristics as unimportant and powerless; excluding them from the center of society.

### THE CHEROKEE TRAIL OF TEARS

The forced removal of more than 15,000 Cherokee from the eastern U.S. to Oklahoma resulted in the deaths of thousands. Fort Armistead, near Coker Creek in Monroe County, was used as a collection point along the historic Unicoi Turnpike.
